

## **Mercury** Systems provide the royal treatment



Steeped in history, the current **Fulham Palace** buildings date from the 15th to 20th century and are Grade One listed. Their national importance meant their new security system needed to protect their future.

With archaeological evidence of Iron Age and Roman settlers and the foundations of a medieval palace, the present site of Fulham Palace is of great historic importance.
